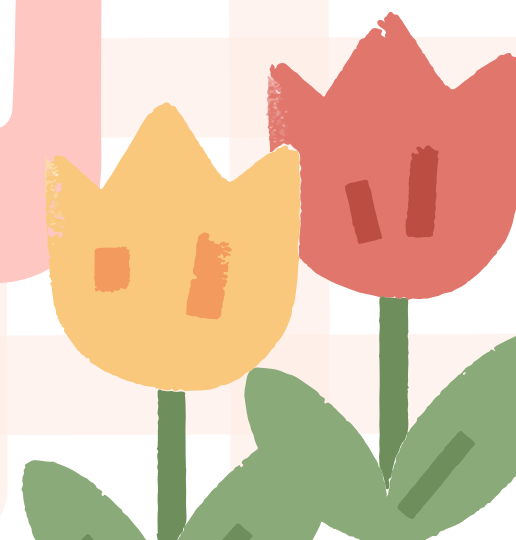

I joined a craft workshop in the arts camp. I created a frame from recycled towel and old clothes. It made me realized that unused things can also be created into amazing art works.



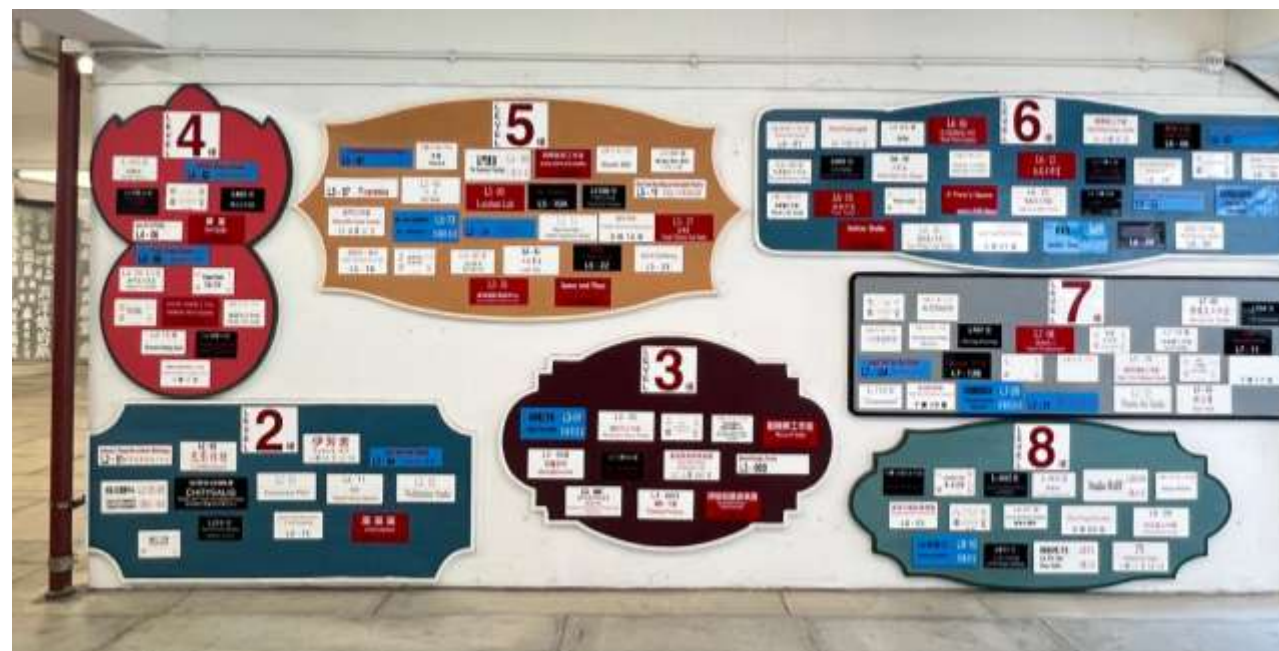

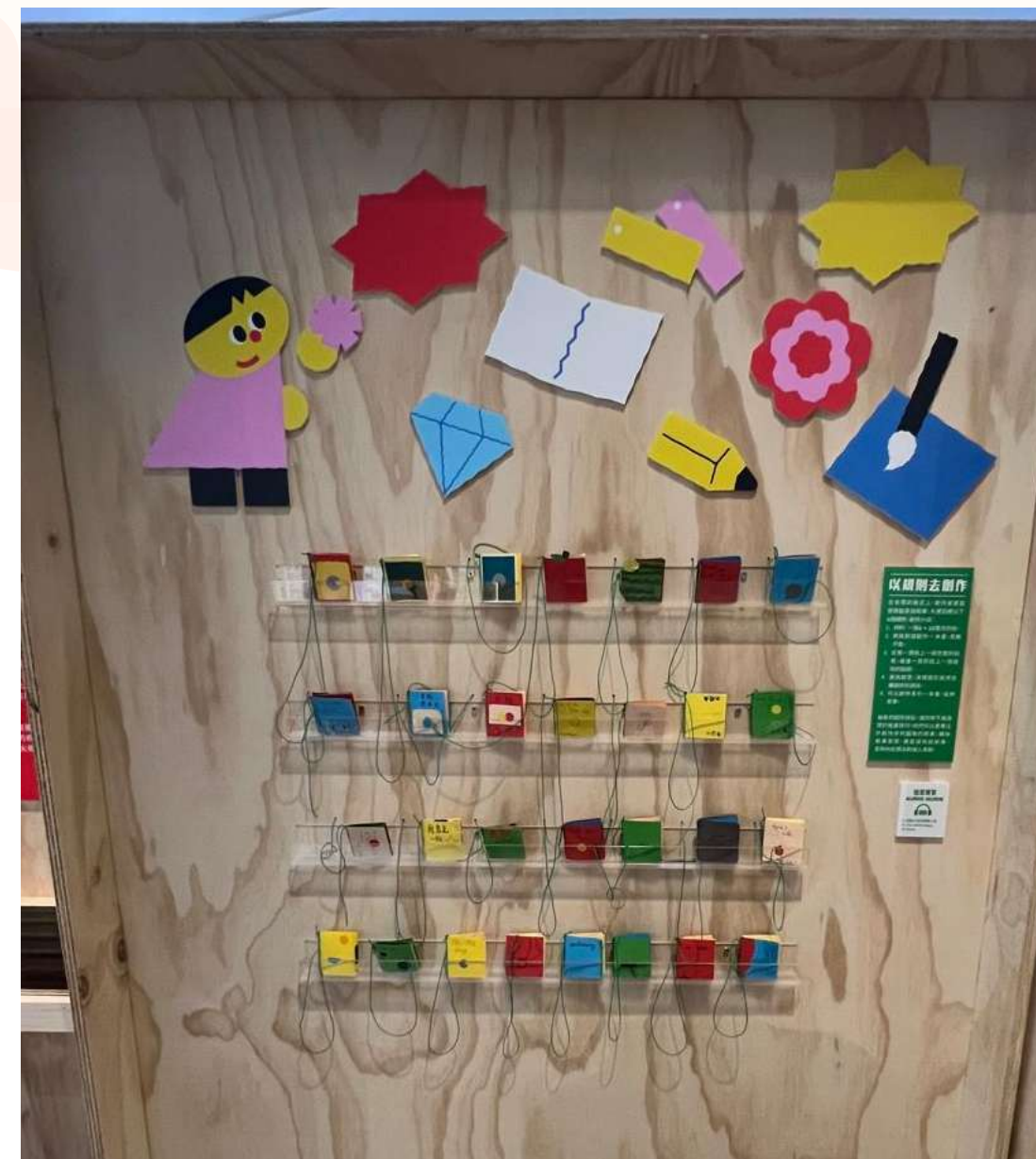
